- All papers should be accompanied by an abstract of 250-300 words and up to 8 keywords.
- Submissions should be in Times Roman 12, double spaced, and with end notes.
- Referencing Style: APA
- Submitted papers must not be under consideration by any other publisher. Authors must attest to this at the time of submission in a cover email, and where relevant disclose any potential conflict of interest regarding the submitted manuscript.
- Author names and institutional affiliations should be provided in the cover email. **Author names should not be inserted in the manuscript itself.**
- All papers submitted to the UCR will be scrutinized by the editors and those suitable will be forwarded for peer review.
